Mission Statement

The Christ the King Catholic Church Scholarship Fund was established to provide educational grants to students who meet the following criteria:

1. Demonstrate academic ability and achievement
2. Demonstrate good moral character
3. Demonstrate dedication and desire for community service

The Fund's mission is to provide grants to students who meet these criteria to assist them in attending accredited colleges and universities in the United States that promote high academic and moral standards. The recipients should in turn strive to improve the society in which they live in a positive manner.

The Christ the King Catholic Church Scholarship Fund is open to all high school seniors whose family are registered members of Christ the King Catholic Church.

Application must be returned in person or postmarked by April 30th, 2022

Basic Scholarship Requirements and Guidelines

The Christ the King Catholic Church Scholarship Fund will award grants to three high school seniors to be used for tuition, books, fees and similar education charges. The amount granted is at the discretion of the Committees, and each grant is anticipated to be \$1,000 for the 2022-2023 academic year.

In order to apply for a grant, the applicant must meet all the following requirements:

Academic Achievement: Applicant must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative grade point average and is in good standing for the current academic semester.

Student Status: Applicant must be a current high school seniors with plans to attend an accredited university, college, junior college or technical school after graduation.

Family Membership/Activities

1. Applicant and family must be current registered member of Christ the King Parish.
2. Applicant must be an active member of a parish organization (choir, Sunday School Teacher/TA, Ephata VD, TNTT, altar servers, lectors...etc)

Required Documents: official transcript, 2 reference letters (no peer or familial sources)

Personal Statement Essay (500 words, single page)

Prompt: As defined by Merriam-Webster, "Character is the way someone thinks, feels, and behaves." Essentially, it's what makes you who you are.

- Describe a time in your life that has shaped who you are as a person.
- How has this experience influenced your commitment to service in school, work, or local community?
- Use this opportunity to tell us something else we cannot see just by looking at your grades or transcripts. What differentiates you from other students who apply to our scholarship?

Award Guidelines

(Please review carefully)

1. Application and supplemental documents must be turned in by April 30th deadline for eligibility.
2. All selected applicants will be notified of their status mid-May and must make themselves available on the chosen date to attend the award ceremony.
3. The scholarship will be presented directly to the winner on the ceremony date.
